Create a winter scene!

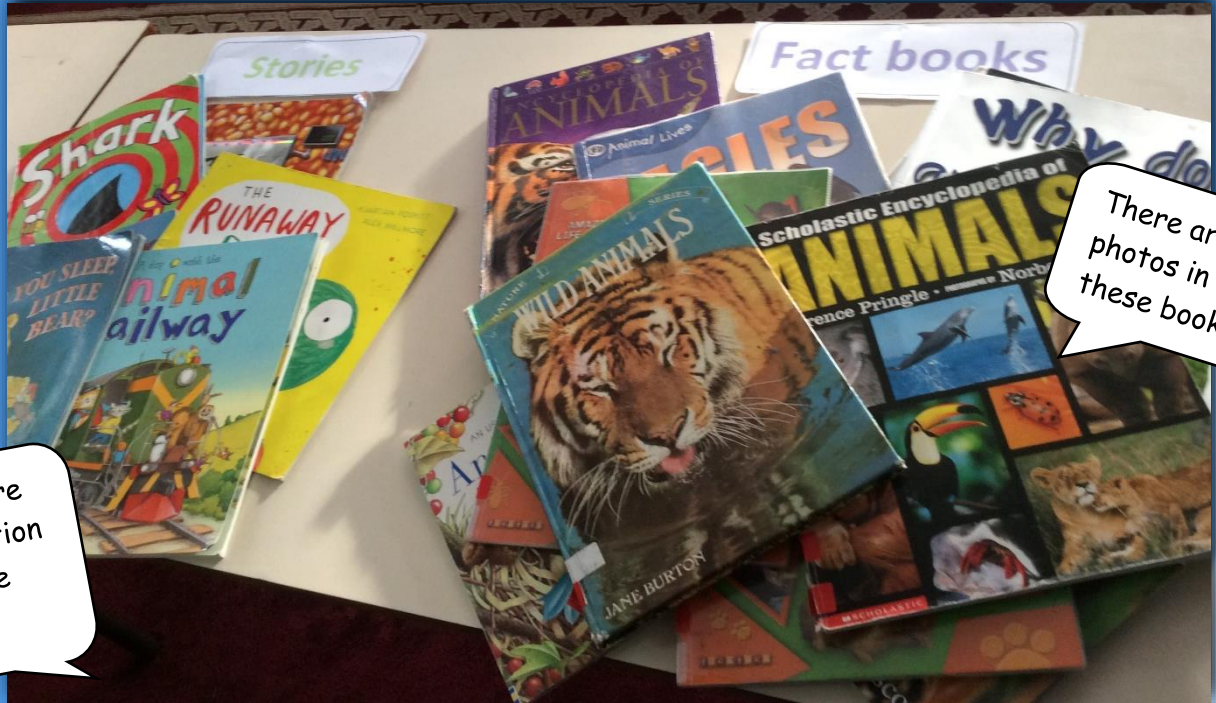


A rain gauge collects rain water so that we can measure how much rain has fallen.
